

Lithofin KF Grout Cleaner

Description

A special product from the LITHOFIN-Range for ceramics, quarry tiles and porcelain (KF). This concentrated cleaner based on alkalines and does not contain any solvents. Active cleaning components are combined with grease and dirt dissolving auxiliary agents.

Properties

Lithofin KF Grout Cleaner dissolves organic dirt, especially oil and grease. After rinsing, the tiles and grout lines are hygienically clean.

Field of Use

For restoring the original colour and appearance of grout lines, and for thoroughly degreasing and cleaning grout in kitchens and bathrooms.

Directions for Use

Put a squirt of Lithofin KF Grout Cleaner onto a moist sponge and apply to the surface to be cleaned. Allow to work for 10 to 15 minutes. In case of very stubborn dirt, use neat and allow to work longer. Support the cleaner by brushing occasionally. Always rinse well with plenty of clear water.

Please Note: we highly recommend testing the product's suitability in an inconspicuous area prior to use. Do not use on surfaces sensitive to alkalines, such as polished marble, lacquered and varnished surfaces, etc. Do not use on hot surfaces.

Coverage: approx. 10m² per litre.

Storage

Closed and cool. Do not store in temperatures above 25°C. Shelf life approx. 3 years.

Environmental Protection

Surfactants are biologically degradable in accordance with EU-regulations.

Disposal: diluted product may be added to waste water.

Containers are made of environmentally friendly polyethylene (PE). Clean containers can be recycled through collection systems.

Safety

Contents: anionic surfactants (<5%), non-ionic surfactants (<5%), alkali, perfume, auxiliary agents.

Risk and Safety Phrases: Labelling according to 1999/45/EG: Symbol Xi, irritant.

Irritating to eyes and skin. Keep out of the reach of children. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice. If swallowed, seek medical advice immediately and show this container or label.

First Aid Procedures: remove contaminated soaked clothing immediately. In case of inhalation, take in fresh air. In the event of symptoms refer for medical treatment. In case of contact with skin wash off immediately with soap and water. In case of contact with eyes rinse thoroughly with plenty of water and seek medical advice. In case of ingestion, do not induce vomiting. If swallowed by mistake drink plenty of water and seek medical treatment.

Emergency Procedures: in case of spill or other release, take up with absorbent material (e.g. sand, sawdust, general-purpose binder). Product does not burn, fire-extinguishing activities according to surrounding. Do not use full water jet for safety reasons.
